Over-the-Counter Savings Bond Sales Ending Soon

As announced a few months ago, the U.S. Department of Treasury will end over-the-counter sales of paper savings bonds on December 31, 2011, including sales through financial institutions and applications mailed directly to the Federal Reserve Bank. Savings bonds will continue to be available for purchase electronically

in Treasury Direct.

Individuals that still wish to purchase savings bonds after the first of the year will need to open a free Treasury Direct account online at www.treasurydirect.gov.

Existing paper bonds are still valid and will continue to earn interest for 30 years from the issue date or until

they are redeemed. Financial institutions will still be able to redeem paper savings bonds after December 31, 2011, just not sell them any longer.

SHAZAM makes Change

Affecting DPB Debit Card Holders

The SHAZAM network recently made a change that affects Dakota Prairie Bank debit card holders. SHAZAM has set SecureCode opt-out parameters to for all MasterCard issuers on their network beginning October 14, 2011. This means our debit card holders performing transactions on a SecureCode enabled website must enroll in SecureCode at the

time of the transaction.

Cardholder enrollment in SecureCode is key to ensuring transactions are not denied by SHAZAM. We encourage our cardholders to enroll in one of the following ways:

- **Standard Activation**—Visit <https://secure.shazam.net/securecode> and follow the prompts to activate

and create a SecureCode.

- **Activation During Shopping (ADS)**—ADS enrollment begins when the cardholder initiates a purchase on any participating SecureCode merchant website. Cardholders will be led through the enrollment process by a series of prompts.
