FACTS	WHAT DOES DAKOTA PRAIRIE BANK DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Dakota Prairie Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes - such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What We Do	
How does Dakota Prairie Bank protect my personal information	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.
How does Dakota Prairie Bank collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open an account • Apply for a loan • Provide account information • Give us your contact information • Show your driver's license • Make a wire transfer We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for non affiliates to market to you State law and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Dakota Prairie Bank has no affiliates.</i>
Non affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Dakota Prairie Bank does not share with non affiliates so they can market you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Dakota Prairie Bank doesn't jointly market.</i>
